Delgado is licensed by the Louisiana Board of Cosmetology (LBC) to provide students with both theory and practical skills in all phases of hairstyling. Students will also be introduced to manicuring, pedicuring, facial services, and makeup. Our student's practical skills are developed through experience in an on-site salon, which is equipped according to industry standards and managed by the students with instructor supervision. Upon completion of this program, students will receive a Technical Diploma and are eligible to take the LA Board of Cosmetology licensure examination.

PROGRAM ADMISSION

In addition to meeting all Delgado admission requirements, students must also meet LBC requirements. Before enrolling into any cosmetology courses, students must be issued a student license from the LBC and attend a mandatory orientation meeting. In order for us to obtain your student license, you must submit the following items to the Sidney Collier Site:

- LA Board of Cosmetology student application
- Birth certificate or driver's license*
- Social security card*
- Two photographs measuring approximately 2" x 2"
- \$10 money order
- Proof of completion of education equal to the 10th grade i.e. official high school, GED transcript or diploma*

*You must bring in the original documents and the staff here will make a copy. We must be able to verify to the board that we have seen the original documents.
