Delgado Celebrates Advanced Technology Center Groundbreaking at West Bank Campus



Delgado Interim Chancellor William Wainwright was joined by Governor John Bel Edwards, State Senator Troy

Carter, and educational, industry, government and economic development officials for a groundbreaking ceremony on May 31, 2019 to establish a new \$13 million Advanced Technology Center at the Delgado's West Bank Campus in Algiers. The center will house academic STEM programs including classrooms, laboratories and faculty offices. The 37,000-square-foot facility is slated to open in May 2021 at the corner of Shirley Drive and Constellation Street, on land acquired by Delgado from the Algiers Development District (ADD).

Delgado intends to increase enrollment at the West Bank Campus and enhance its partnerships with key industries by fostering innovation, education, and technology in an academic environment at the new center. The investment will give the school the capacity to teach 2,000 more students in addition to its current enrollment of 2,500. The center will focus on the healthcare, petrochemical, digital media and transportation logistics industries; create a workforce pipeline for the West Bank's industrial needs; and ensure access to higher education.

Nunez Community College and Delgado Partner to Offer Transfer Pathways

Nunez Community College signed an articulation agreement with Delgado Community College on June 17, 2019 that offers students at both colleges enhanced access to more educational opportunities.

The historic agreement establishes a pathway for Nunez students to transfer coursework and complete an Associate of Applied Science in Veterinary Technology, Respiratory Technology, or Radiologic Technology at Delgado, and for Delgado students to transfer coursework to complete an Associate of Applied Science in Process Technology or Aerospace Manufacturing Technology at Nunez.

Both Nunez and Delgado are accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award associate degrees, certificates, and diplomas.
