



The Uplift Scholarship program is a partnership between Delgado Community College and The PepsiCo Foundation to address education inequalities facing the African American and Hispanic populations. The program supports Black and Hispanic students pursuing two-year degrees and professional certificate programs.

Scholarships awarded to qualifying students help offset tuition and other costs. The scholarship program offers academic and technical training courses to help students complete their education and earn jobs in high-growth, high-demand fields. The program also provides students with dedicated success coaches, access to emergency grants, and financial literacy courses.

### **MJ Foster Promise**

The MJ Foster Promise is a state funded program that provides financial aid for tuition and fees for up to three years at Louisiana public two-year post-secondary institutions and a limited number of proprietary schools. Funding can be used for credentials (academic or non-credit) that align with high-demand jobs in five growing industry sectors: construction, healthcare / social assistance, information technology, manufacturing, and transportation / warehousing. The first class begins July 2022. Qualifications are as follows:

- Louisiana residents aged 21+ without associates degree
- No merit-based barriers (GPA/ACT)

- 300% FPL family income or 6 months unemployed (FAFSA req.)
- No HS diploma, but must co-enroll in HISET
- Attestation to remain in Louisiana and perform 20 hours of service
- Former nonviolent offenders eligible on release
