The MJ Foster Promise is a state funded program that provides financial aid for



tuition and fees for up to three years at Louisiana public two-year post-secondary institutions and a limited number of proprietary schools. Funding can be used for credentials (academic or non-credit) that align to highdemand jobs five growing industry sectors:

Construction

Health Care and Social Assistance Information Technology

Manufacturing

Transportation and Warehousing


Who Will Qualify:

- Louisiana residents aged 21+ without associates degree
- No merit-based barriers (GPA/ACT)
- 300% FPL family income or 6 months un-employed (FAFSA req.)
- No HS diploma, but must co-enroll in HISET Attestation to remain in La. and perform 20 hours of service
- Former nonviolent offenders eligible on release

First class begins July 2022.
