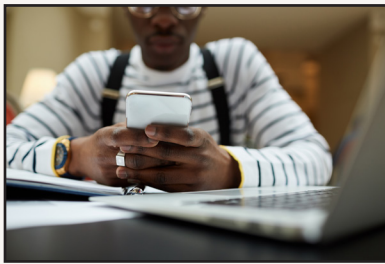

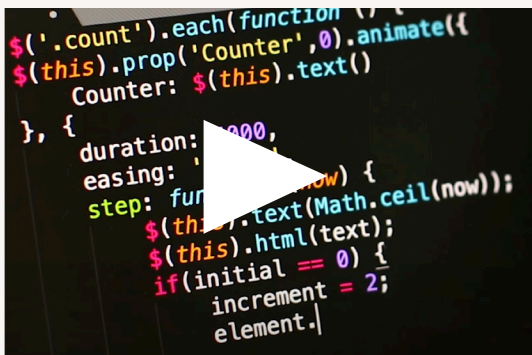

Program Spotlight: Cloud Computing

Cloud Computing is the technology which reduces costs for processing, storing, and securing large amounts of data by using on-demand networked computers instead of local hardware to develop a system's information technology infrastructure.

Delgado offers both a Cloud Computing Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) and a Career and Technical Certificate (C.T.C.) in Cloud Computing Foundations. The average salary for skills in Cloud Computing is over \$120,000 annually. The average salary for a Cloud Support Associate is \$85,000 annually.
