Program Spotlight

Diagnostic Medical Sonography

Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS) is one of the most highly developed and complex diagnostic imaging modalities of the medical field. DMS involves the use of low intensity, high frequency acoustical waves to provide diagnostic information about human anatomy and pathology.

Ultrasound is one of the more operator dependent examinations in diagnostic imagery. The diagnostic medical sonographer, or person who creates ultrasound images with sophisticated instrumentation, has a very important role in the process of providing a patient with an optimal exam.

The DMS program at Delgado Community College is a 16-month accredited program of formal and practical education in diagnostic medical sonography. Classes

start in the fall semester (August) and extend through the following December. The deadline to submit completed applications including documents and transcripts is May 1 of each year.

Those who find a career in Diagnostic Medical Sonography can earn between \$ 57,530 and \$ 82,320 per year, while exceptional performers can earn in excess of \$ 99,100. *Figures are based on data collected from the U.S. Department of Labor.*

Library Services



Delgado Libraries support students, faculty, and staff through a variety of services and resources, both online and on site at our six locations: City Park Campus, West Bank Campus, Charity School of Nursing,

Jefferson Site, Sidney Collier Site, and River City Site.

Each library is open at 8 a.m. Monday through Friday, and those seeking evening or weekend access may visit select locations until 8 p.m. or on Saturdays. Visit the Delgado Libraries website at <https://dcc.libguides.com/library> for hours of operation at each site.

Regarding Delgado Libraries' physical spaces, patrons can reserve group study rooms, utilize study tables and seating in a quiet environment, and work individually at computers stations. Projects can be scanned or printed at dedicated, networked printing stations.

For those searching for published information, Delgado Libraries provide immediate access to thousands of books, journals, documents, magazines, and newspapers in hard copy form pertaining to all subject areas. If patrons need assistance, they may refer to an available librarian at the front desk for help finding relevant research, locating digital or physical resources, requesting off-site materials, or borrowing selected items from the collection.

When busy schedules hinder a visit to one of the locations around the city, the Delgado Libraries website allows patrons to virtually search for desired materials through the online catalog, or via any of over 150 discrete,

multidisciplinary and specialized databases. Digital avenues provide access to hundreds of thousands of e-books, image bases, electronic journals, and even video holdings. There are also dozens of useful research guides for nearly every discipline. Although remote database entry and resource downloads require current logon credentials, librarians are there at every step, with web chat and Text a Librarian features to answer any questions at 504-322-3655.
