# **Dual Enrollment Program**

Our Dual Enrollment program is for students who have the ability to benefit from instruction in either their chosen career path or enrollment in a transferable course at the College in their sophomore, junior, and senior years of high school. Upon successful completion, students will receive high school units and credit from Delgado Community College!

### **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

For acceptance into Dual Enrollment, students must:

- Have parental and school administration permission.
- Be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, or 9th grade in some instances.
- Be eligible for course(s) per ACT score or Delgado placement assessment scores.
- Must have a 2.5 G.P. A on a 4.0 scale and be in good standing as defined by the high school

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

Prospective Dual Enrollment students are required to submit the following documents signed by the appropriate parties. Incomplete applications will not be processed. Visit dcc.edu/go/dual-enrollment and complete both:

- 1. Delgado Admissions Application
- 2. Dual Enrollment Paper Application

Submit ACT scores and transcript with Dual Enrollment Paper Application to your high school counselor. Contact Dual Enrollment if you have not taken the ACT.

#### MAXIMUM ENROLLMENT ALLOWED

Fall Semester - 18 credit hours Spring Semester - 18 credit hours Summer Session - 9 credit hours

#### PROGRAM COSTS AND FUNDING COSTS

Courses are \$50 per credit hour for all modules (online, hybrid, and face-to-face). Add an additional \$25 per credit hour for courses with Delgado Course Complete fees.

# Program Spotlight: Care and Development of Young Children (CDYC)



Delgado Community College's
Associate of Applied Science in
Care and Development of Young
Children (CDYC) is designed to
prepare students for the workforce
and occupations in careers working
with young children. The program
has a strong community connection
and is a liaison with several childcare
directors in the field. Our program:

- Forged partnerships with local public and private school systems at the parish and state level.
- Works closely with head starts at the federal level to ensure that their employees they have a quality education that fits their needs while fulfilling new state guidelines (CLASS training through CDA classes and integration of subject matter with our CDYC courses)
- Has articulation agreements with SUNO and the University of Holy Cross.

#### PROGRAM OFFERINGS

Associate of Applied Science in Care and Development of Young Children (CDYC)

The Associate of Applied Science degree provides a learning-centered environment in which to prepare students from diverse backgrounds to attain their educational and

career goals in the area of working developmentally appropriately with young children and families.

# Early Childhood Ancillary Certificate Program

This program is BESE-approved and combines online courses with in-class mentoring-coaching for each participant in three concurrent semesters.

### **MJ Foster Promise**

The MJ Foster Promise is a state funded program that provides financial aid for tuition and fees for up to three years at Louisiana public two-year post-secondary institutions and a limited number of proprietary schools. Funding can be used for credentials (academic or non-credit) that align with high-demand jobs in five growing industry sectors: construction, healthcare / social assistance, information technology, manufacturing, and transportation / warehousing. The first class begins July 2022. Qualifications are as follows:

- Louisiana residents aged 21+ without associates degree
- No merit-based barriers (GPA/ACT)
- 300% FPL family income or 6 months unemployed (FAFSA req.)
- No HS diploma, but must co-enroll in HISET
- Attestation to remain in Louisiana and perform 20 hours of service
- Former nonviolent offenders eligible on release
