Precision Machining

The Precision Machining Certificate of Technical Studies (C.T.S.) Program prepares individuals to shape metal parts on machines such as lathes, grinders, drill presses, milling machines, as well as computer numerical controlled (CNC) machines.

The program includes making computations for dimensions, cutting feeds and speeds, using precision measuring instruments, laying out parts, and heat treatment of metals.

Located at the Delgado River City Site is the Advanced Manufacturing Center, which provides a fully equipped laboratory with Integrated Systems Technology (IST) that combines hands-on skills training with curriculum, as well as industry-based certifications, simulated and virtual training and online multimedia access.

It takes approximately nine months to complete the precision machining program.

The average salary for jobs that require precision machining skills is \$94,667 based on United States National Average (Source: salary.com).
