Admission Requirements/Process for Transition ADN-RN Program

Requirements

- Must have a High School diploma or High School equivalency.
- Must be a licensed LPN in good standing with the Louisiana State Board of Nursing.
- Graduates of the Delgado Charity School of Nursing LPN program are guaranteed admission into the ADN RN Program after meeting program requirements.
- An overall grade point average of 2.500 in any general education and required related courses in the School of Nursing curriculum.
- ✤ Grade of "C" or higher in all required related courses and general education courses.
- Delgado Community College GPA of 2.000 or higher, if applicable.
- Kaplan Pre-Nursing Exam Scores (Critical Thinking, Science, Math, Reading and Writing).
 - Test MUST be taken at Delgado Community College, before submitting online application.
 - Test scores expire after 3 years. Kaplan test may not be repeated until 140 days have elapsed from the date of your previous test. The most recent eligible scores will be used to calculate your Profile score.
 - If your application is different from the name used to take your Kaplan exam, you must provide proof of the name change by emailing documents to csnadmissions@dcc.edu.

- Completion of the following before applying with a final grade of "C" or better:
 - Anatomy and Physiology I BIOL 251/253 (3 credit hrs. of lecture; 1 hr. of lab)
 - Anatomy and Physiology II BIOL 252/254 (3 credit hrs. of lecture; 1 hr. of lab)
 - English 101 (3 credit hrs.)
 - English 102 (3 credit hrs.)
 - Math (6 credit hrs. of Math MATH 130 or higher. Recommend Math 130 and Math 203)
 - Microbiology BIOL 210 or BIOL 211 (3 credit hrs.)
 - General Psychology PSYC 127 (3 credit hrs.)
 - Fine Arts Elective (3 credit hrs.) See catalog for a list of accepted courses.
 - Humanities Elective (3 credit hrs.) See catalog for a list of accepted courses.
- Ability to meet the Technical Standards as attested to on the nursing application.
- A student may not have four or more enrollments resulting in grades D, F or W in Human Anatomy and Physiology I and II (BIOL 251, 253, 252 and 254) or the equivalent, taken within the last 5 years of possible entry into the program.

Process

- Visit <u>www.dcc.edu</u> and complete the general Delgado Community College admission procedures if not currently a Delgado Student.
- Complete the Kaplan Pre-Nursing Exam (see above).
- Complete the online nursing program application via the link on the Registered Nursing program Delgado website. <u>https://www.dcc.edu/academics/charity-school-nursing/programs/registered-nursing/default.aspx</u>
- If applicable, submit the following documents to: <u>csnadmissions@dcc.edu</u>
 - Transfer Reference Sheet for any student who has attended another Nursing program within the last 5 years.  - Course descriptions for any Clinical Nursing or Pharmacology courses taken outside of Delgado Community College for which transfer credit is requested.

Admission Requirements/Process for Transition ADN-RN Program

- Send official transcripts of all colleges attended outside of Delgado Community College to the Delgado Community College Registrar's Office, <u>healthsciencetrans@dcc.edu</u>. Paper copies of all transcripts must also be mailed to Delgado Community College, Registrar's Office, 615 City Park Avenue, New Orleans, LA 70119. If you have attended a college that is part of the LCTCS (BPCC, BRCC, CLTCC, LDCC, FTCC, NTCC, NCC, NLTC, RPCC, SLCC, SOWELA), you must request your transcript to be downloaded into your LoLA account <u>and</u> send an official printed copy of the LCTCS transcript to the Registrar's Office at City Park. - It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all transfer credits have been approved by the Registrar's Office and are posted on their LOLA online transcript. Coursework not posted on the LoLA transcript will not be included in the application evaluation process.
- No applicant will be considered for admission until all of the required documents are received.
