Who is eligible for HEERF funds?

First-Time Freshman, Returning, Continuing, and Transfer students enrolled for the Spring 2022 semester
AND
Students with exceptional need (as defined below).

Please note: Dual-Enrolled, Workforce, Non-Matriculating, and Visiting students are not eligible.

What is a student with exceptional need?

A student with exceptional need is a student that has paid or authorized Pell Grant.

OR

A student that has a recent financial hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

I do not have a paid or authorized Pell Grant but have exceptional need. How do I receive HEERF funds?

When will I receive my funds in my account?

All eligible students will have funds in their account (refunded) no later than May 11th.

I already received HEERF funds in the amount of \$1,000. I am now full-time (12+ hours); will I receive the additional funds?

Yes. You do not need to take any additional action. You will automatically receive the additional \$200 if you are now enrolled full-time (12+ hours).

I received \$1,200 in HEERF funds in February 2022. Am I eligible?

No.
