**FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID:** You may be eligible for federal grants or loans. Get started TODAY! Schedule one-on-one, live FAFSA assistance and financial counseling at [mosaiec.org/coaching](http://mosaiec.org/coaching). Complete the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov). Delgado's school code is 004626. You will need these documents:


- Income (If you are a dependent, parent information is also required):
- Federal Tax Return: 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ or IRS Tax Return Transcript. (Note: It is recommended you use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool option when completing the FAFSA. This will ensure the information is accurate and limit the chance of being selected for verification).
- W2 form(s) if you worked but were not required to file a tax return.
- Social Security number
- Alien registration number (if applicable)
- Untaxed income such as child support received, veterans non-education benefits, workers compensation.

## Ways Delgado Student Services can help:

- ▶ **Call the FAFSA help line** at **1 (877) 845-9883**, sponsored by Trellis, a trusted Delgado partner: Monday - Thursday, 8 a.m. - 6 p.m. and Friday, 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- ▶ **Visit in person** at the City Park Campus, Building 2. Check-in at the Welcome Desk on the first floor: Monday, Wednesday, Friday, 1 p.m. - 4 p.m. and Tuesday, Thursday, 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. We offer **bilingual (Spanish) FAFSA assistance**: Tuesday, Thursday, 1 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.

## Get started on completing your FAFSA today!

- 1. Complete FAFSA.** Visit [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) to fill out your FAFSA. Need help? Schedule one-on-one, live FAFSA assistance and financial counseling at [mosaiec.org/coaching](https://mosaiec.org/coaching).
- 2. Check Eligibility.** Check your “Fin Aid Status” in LoLA ([my.lctcs.edu](https://my.lctcs.edu)) to see if you have unmet requirements. Document review takes up to 15 business days.
- 3. Accept Award.** Check “Award for Aid Year” in LoLA. If you accept loans, complete a Master Promissory Note and Loan Entrance Counseling at [studentloans.gov](https://studentloans.gov).
